

Afterthoughts to the Midlight Meditation, 13 Ahau and 1 Imix (June 1-2, 2005): The End to Dominance

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At the very significant energy shift of the midpoint of the Galactic Underworld thousands of people gathered around the planet in order to celebrate and deepen the process of moving away from the civilization of dominance and submission that for about 5000 years (ever since the beginning of the Mayan Long Count) has ruled our planet. The Midlight Meditation of June 1-2, 2005 was the sequel to the Oneness Celebration that was celebrated last year as the planet Venus passed across the disc of the sun thus signaling the beginning of the final phase of ascension of humanity. Hence, the Midlight Meditation occurred 360 (and not 365) days after the Oneness Celebration in line with the non-mechanical, non-astronomical basis of the prophetic Mayan calendar and the divine time plan. The Midlight Meditation was also a shift between two Sacred Calendar rounds of 260 days with one ending with the refined energy of enlightenment (13 Ahau or Light) on June 1 and another beginning the day after with the energy of primordial origin (1 Imix or Alligator).

It is probably true that without the planet Venus as a signal a smaller number of people felt called to participate this year, but the participation was not by any means any less widespread. In significant regards the current event meant major steps forward on humanity's path towards enlightenment that accounted for a greater impact on the global evolution of consciousness than the numbers would indicate. People participated from New Zealand to Chile and from Siberia to the American West Coast and in a very large number of places in between. This large and widespread participation by itself attests to the fact that people all over the world are now starting to align with the rhythm of the Mayan calendar and have become inclined to celebrate its major energy shifts because of their won resonance with it. In my view, the purpose of the Mayan calendar is to make the divine time plan conscious and the larger scale on which this is happening the greater are the prospects for this time plan to manifest what it is meant to. The more the Mayan calendar with its time plan for the emergence of a non-dualist consciousness becomes known the more meaningful will it seem for people at large to focus on projects that are life-enhancing. Thus, the dissemination of the Mayan calendar with the hope for the future that it presents serves the survival of our planet in accordance with its intended divine destiny.

The Midlight Meditation included the first globally synchronized diksha days, by means of which a possibility is opening up to bring an enlightened state not only to individuals, but also to the entire global life system, the global brain as such that we may all see ourselves as integral parts of. If we see ourselves as parts of the system to be transformed we will have much more power to set things right than if we see ourselves as separate from the Earth. This is a subtle but nonetheless very important distinction that is tantamount to taking a step to a higher galactic level of consciousness.

Naturally, these are possibilities that are only likely to come to fruition as we come to the close of the Galactic Underworld and the processes that we are in now have matured in many different ways. Nonetheless, I feel an enormous hope because of the network and the tools that have now been created, which may come to be activated for even deeper global transformations at later significant shift points in the Mayan calendar. Among those participating the divine intelligence brought by Bagavan and Amma through the diksha will already have served to somewhat rewire the global brain and transform humanity into a more balanced body.

It has been said that all human suffering is a result of the experience of separation from the divine. According to what we know from the Mayan calendar one of the first results of this separation 5000 years ago was the patriarchal civilization of dominance and submissiveness that since then in varying forms have ruled life on the planet. Through the unified meditation and diksha days celebrated at the significant shift point in the Mayan calendar on June 1-2, 2005 it seems like many, by lifting themselves to a higher galactic perspective, have now developed tools to help bring this separation and its associated world of dominance to an end as we approach the end of the Galactic Underworld on October 28, 2011.

This is not to say that a global diksha is already a perfected tool for the future. Global diksha and meditation days on shift points in the Mayan calendar will hopefully come to include many other movements and techniques that in other ways are contributing to the end of dominance and the enlightenment of humanity. Yet, a network to develop a common path from has been established and to me its concerted and synchronized participation is a great source of hope (see www.onenesscelebration.com and www.livinginjoy.com). Also, let us not forget that part of the purpose of the Midlight Meditation was in a magical way to celebrate life with all kinds of diverse expressions.

The above pertains to the process of enlightenment, but we may also ask whether in terms of world politics we saw any signs of a change away from the civilization of dominance that might have been associated with this significant energy shift in the Mayan calendar. I feel there were some significant signs of this. Very notably the referendums in two founding nations of the European Community, France and the Netherlands, came out against the proposed European constitution. The shift in attitudes to this constitution that has taken place in the electorates also of some other member countries has been so dramatic and rapid at the same time that it has stunned the poll makers. And the shift in attitude has taken place without any apparent external reason, which is also exactly what you would expect if it is the result of a cosmic energy shift.

What is the significance of this? Up until now the peoples of Europe have been essentially favorable to integration of their economies ever since the inauguration of the Coal and Steel Union in 1952. At this midpoint of the Galactic Underworld this willingness seems however to have come to a halt. How does this relate to the end to dominance? The core of the issue of the European constitution is whether Europe should have a dominating central presidential executive that would give the union the power to act as one force in global politics.

In my own view, the peoples of Europe have favored steps to an economic union, but are now wisely questioning the need to turn it into a centralized power. Who needs a president? Many are sensing that Europe has much greater possibilities of contributing to world peace, by being a buffer in the conflicts between the East and the West than by trying to participate in the power struggles itself. This I see as a subtle, but very significant shift away from a world from dominance that coincided with the Midlight Meditation.

In the United States of America not many go as far as questioning the institution of the presidency, which is being bolstered by an almost endless number of movies that seems to emphasize its supreme importance. Nonetheless, very significant events took place there too, with the same meaning as in Europe. June 2 (beginning the new tzolkin round with 1 Imix) was the UN World Environment Day with a large scale gathering of mayors in San Francisco. The most significant thing that was linked to this conference was probably Governor Schwarzenegger's (republican) signing of a bill committing the state of California to abide by the Kyoto protocol and decrease the emission of greenhouse gases. This was in fact part of a widespread movement on the state and local levels including mayors of many large cities in the United States to voluntarily abide by the Kyoto protocol despite the refusal of the centralized presidential power to do so. The message is exactly the same as the votes in Europe: avoiding or sidestepping the presidential dominance (the heirs to the pharaohs and priest kings that came to rule 5000 years ago). Increasingly people will start to ask ³Who needs it?² Given the role of oil and petro-dollars in the US strategy for world dominance this voluntary abiding by the Kyoto protocol has extensive ramifications. In fact, it should not be ignored that a path away from a world of dominance may come out of a shift to energy sources that cannot be centrally controlled in the way oil can. While the Mayan calendar may tell us about when a specific change in consciousness will happen, it does not tell us of how it manifests. Forthcoming highly effective solar panels, as now seem to be under production may be a surprising way facilitating the path towards global balance and its continuation into enlightened states.

Both of these things may seem subtle and different from revolutionary turnover of hierarchical and dominating structures. Yet, I think all profound change starts very subtly, initially with people hardly noticing what is happening. A world without dominance and separation can never come about through confrontation or violence, which would only recreate the dominance in a new form. Thus, we can only work towards the goal of an enlightened planet with means that are completely in accordance with the enlightened and peaceful world that we want to create. On these days, the Midlight Meditation at the midpoint of the Galactic Underworld, subtle signs have presented themselves that people both in Europe and the United States are beginning to circumvent and sidestep executive presidential dominance in a way that I feel is very promising for the future. At the same time, for the first time ever, a globally synchronized diksha day was a means used by divine intelligence to rewire the global brain serving to change its very biology.
